Here is an update on the National UCW outreach project, **Women for Change: Zambia**. I received word that donations received up till May 10, 2022 amounted to \$83,663.49. In addition, there is a transfer of \$10,000 from the UCW Life Membership funds. Way to go, UCWs!

Prairie to Pine Bursary Report was given by Darlynne Smith, convenor of the bursary committee. These candidates for ministry had received Prairie to Pine Bursaries in 2021: Pat Chabluk, Jen Carter-Morgan, and Damber Khadka.

Darlynne also reported that no application was received for the bursary offered by Prairie to Pine UCW. The **UCW Bursary** of \$800 is awarded annually from Prairie to Pine Regional UCW funds to persons, at least 18 years of age, (and not in, or studying towards, paid accountable ministry). The applicant must be actively involved in, and taking a course that would benefit a local United Church Community of Faith. Please encourage members of your Community of Faith who would benefit from this bursary, to apply in the future.
