Request for approval of Provisional Appointment for Zach Kakegamic at Adam Fiddler Memorial United Church, Sandy Lake Having received from Adam Fiddler United Church (Sandy Lake, Ontario): a position description for a full-time ministry position; motion from meeting of the Board/Community of Faith on October 1, 2023; a completed Record of Appointment for Zach (Sacharius) Kakegamic; and having received confirmation from the Indigenous Vocational Minister that he has completed his 2023 Annual Declaration Regarding Criminal Charges and Criminal Record (ADCCCR) and updated all mandatory trainings, and confirmation that finances are in place for FTE (Full Time Equivalency) the Pastoral Relations Commission approves the Provisional Appointment of ZACH (SACHARIUS) KAKEGAMIC to a full-time ministry position (40 hours per week) at Adam Fiddler United Church, (Sandy Lake, Ontario) effective October 1, 2023 to December 31, 2024, conditional upon his ordination by the Indigenous Ministries Council on October 22, 2023, with the following terms:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1.
