In a time of ongoing conflict, join us for an evening that centres the voices of women working toward peace from both sides of the Israel-Palestine divide. Hosted by the Winnipeg chapter of Women Wage Peace (WWP), this program brings together dialogue, lived experience and music to explore pathways toward a just and sustainable peace.

The evening program was developed in collaboration with the Canadian Museum for Human Rights and features a keynote address by social justice activist Dr. Amal Elsana Alhjoor. Her keynote, *Women's voices and actions: Humanity, justice and peace* will be followed by a moderated conversation between Dr. Alhjoor and WWP co-founder Rabbi Donna Kirshbaum.

For those who wish to deepen their engagement, three workshops organized exclusively by Women Wage Peace with the support of Westworth United Church and New Israel Fund will take place earlier in the day.
