Motion 2026-28

Moved by Kenneth, seconded by Chuck, that the minutes of the meeting of June 2, 2026 be approved. Carried.

Motion 2026-29

Moved by Wayne, seconded by Chuck, that Prairie to Pine Property Commission give its consent to the trustees of Kenton United Church to list or seek to sell certain Real Property, the legal description of which is Roll Number 417300.000, 15-2-126, 16-2-126, NW 06-12-23-W, and the civic address is 332 Cornwall Street in Kenton, Manitoba. Motion 2026-30

Moved by Chuck, seconded Kenneth, that Prairie to Pine Property Commission give its consent to the Trustees of Rock Lake United Church for the sale of certain Real Property, the legal description of which is Lots 1-11, Block 3, Plan 59, Roll Number 301000.000, ORG NE-24-02-12-w, ORG NW-24-02-24-w, ORG SE-25-02-12-w, ORG SW-25-02-12-w, and the civic address is 36 South Railway Avenue West, in Crystal City, Manitoba, pursuant to an agreement between the Board of Trustees of Rock Lake United Church, a congregation of The United Church of Canada, as seller and Rod & Kristi Guildford as purchasers, and that the funds arising from said sale to be disbursed in accordance with the policies of the Prairie to Pine Regional Council. Carried

Ken reported he attended a Teams meeting with Churchill Park and the Provincial Early Learning and Child Care regarding funding for the daycare project. There is another meeting with Assiniboine Credit Union later today. The project is advancing, but slowly.
